1. Introduction

Our website uses cookies, which are small text files placed on your device when you visit our website. There are many different types of cookies and they are widely used on vast numbers of websites for various reasons. For example, some cookies are used for making websites function properly and/or more efficiently and/or provide information to website owners and/or targeted advertising.

2. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to explain the different types cookies we use, their purpose and when they expire.

3. Types of Cookies

We use the following types of cookies on our website:

Strictly Necessary Cookies

Strictly necessary cookies are used for things like supporting functions such as, logging in and remembering what is in your shopping basket and payment transactions.

Analytics Cookies

Analytics cookies collect information about how easy it is for you to navigate around our website and which features you use. The information we collect assists us in improving our website.

Functionality Cookies

Functionality cookies enable us to remember your saved preferences. Some functionality cookies can also be strictly necessary cookies, but not all.

Targeting Cookies

Targeting cookies help us to understand you better and make our website and advertising more relevant to you by collecting information about which parts of our website you have visited and which links you have used. Some of the information we collect using targeting cookies may also be shared with third parties.

First Party Cookies

First party cookies are placed by us and are used for the purpose of improving your experience of our website and/or improving our services.

Persistent Cookies

Any of the above types of cookies may also be persistent cookies. Persistent cookies stay on your device after you have left our website.

Session Cookies

Any of the above types of cookies may be session cookies. Session cookies are not permanent, as they only stay on your device for as long as you are visiting our website, following which they are deleted.

We Do Not Use Third Party Cookies

Third party cookies are placed by third parties such as, advertising services in order to provide you with advertising suited to you. These cookies work in the same way as analytics cookies described above. We do not use Third Party Cookies on our website.

4. Consent for Cookies

Before setting cookies on your device, we ask for your consent to do so. If you agree, this enables us to provide you with the best possible experience when visiting our website. If you decline, certain functions within our website may not operate effectively. That said, strictly necessary cookies will function, as we do not need consent to place these types of cookies.
